An apprenticeship framework is based around an NVQ (National Vocational Qualification). These qualifications are developed and approved, and are designed to measure your practical skills and job knowledge by assessing your work on-site.

As part of your apprenticeship you will also:

- Gain a Technical Certificate
- Complete a Health & Safety Test
- Achieve the appropriate level of key skills assessment

The apprenticeship programme is designed to help you prepare for a career on site, and to ensure you get the right qualification to get into the construction industry, including qualifying for the appropriate card scheme.

Your employer may also be able to claim a grant of up to £9,400 to support you through a 3 year apprenticeship.
